Embracing Health Care Changes: Be Informed, Help Educate, Become an Advocate September 28, 2017 Radisson Hotel, Milwaukee West

In February 2017, the Milwaukee Board of School Directors approved a district-wide uniform policy for all students starting in the 2017-18 school year. Beginning with the first day of school for your child, either August 14th for early start schools or September 5th for all traditional calendar schools, all students in grades K-12 will be required to comply with the school uniform policy.

The policy sets uniform guidelines for all Milwaukee Public Schools; pants must be tan, navy blue or black khaki-style pants with black or navy blue polo shirts. A student may wear any combination of the official district uniform colors or school- identified colors as approved by the principal and School Governance Council
