Where to start your job search

Starting a new job search can be stressful. Broadscope is here to help decrease that stress with tips on finding a job and being successful at your job. It's helpful to know what types of jobs you are interested in and where to find job postings.

Some common websites to find job postings are Milwaukee County Human Resources, City of Milwaukee Jobs, Indeed and Jobs That Help. You can also go directly to a company's website to look at what jobs they have open. For example, if you are interested in working at grocery store, you can go directly to the Pick 'n Save website and click on the Careers button at the bottom of the page.

Scams on online job boards have been increasingly more common. Sometimes scammers will impersonate an employee at a real company. It's best to always look up the company to verify that job opportunities are legitimate. Remember to never send personal information or accept money from someone claiming to be a recruiter.
